

How PolypVac works



Visit Your Doctor

Polyp removal with PolypVac is often performed during routine office or clinic visits, as soon as the need for polyp removal is identified.



Numb Your Nose

Polyps aren't sensitive, and removing them is relatively painless. The doctor will typically spray anesthetic and/or decongestant to open the nasal passages.



Remove Your Polyps

The doctor uses an endoscope to see the polyps, then removes them with PolypVac.



You're Good to Go!

The procedure is often completed within several minutes. Once completed, you are able to leave the office and resume normal activities.

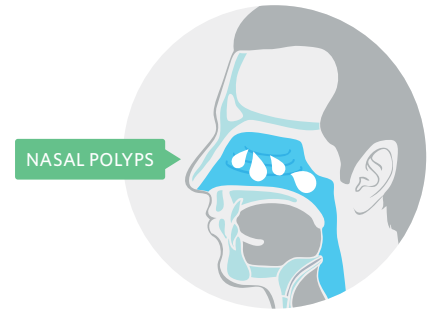


Nobody wants nasal polyps

Up to 12 million people in the US alone have nasal polyps.

Nasal polyps are relatively common growths in the lining of the nose. They can block nasal passages, preventing normal sinus drainage and leading to difficulties breathing, smelling, and sleeping.

Their exact cause is unknown, but they result from inflammation and are often associated with infection, asthma, allergies, aspirin sensitivity, and immune disorders.



Introducing PolypVac

PolypVac is a new, FDA-cleared technology that enables your physician to safely remove nasal polyps in the clinic without the need for general anesthesia.

Goodbye blockage

PolypVac significantly and immediately reduces symptoms, including nasal blockage, associated with nasal polyps. In a clinical study, 97% of patients reported a comfort level of 'fair' to 'excellent' and the procedure took only several minutes per side.¹

Hello airflow

After polyp removal using PolypVac, there is greater access for medicated sprays and rinses later, keeping symptoms at bay while minimizing polyp recurrence.
